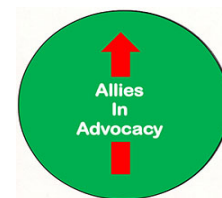

The White House is looking for people with IDD to serve on the President's committee. Several SAIL members are interested. People need to submit a resume and a short bio of themselves by July 16th, 2021

SAIL members brainstormed ideas for 2022 legislative priorities

1. shut down the IDD Institutions
2. Nothing about us without us bill
3. Advocating to modify Ruckelshaus bill
4. Transportation - increase service areas, improve hours, and better paratransit services
5. Housing-increase more affordable accessible housing, increase community residential services
6. Increase pay for caregivers / decrease turnover, teach providers about client rights
7. Employment-better training on job coaches/help decrease high turnover rates / make services person centered/ need more jobs and career opportunities job coaches need to respect the person with IDD with what they want
8. Increase DD budget items
9. Technology first
10. Improve hate laws against those who are disabled and LGBTQIA
11. Improve Medicaid services / increase medical coverage overall
